

## Community College Scholarship

*Peirce College awards this scholarship to our students who are graduates of Community College*

### Criteria

- Students must have completed their Associate Degree at one of our partner community colleges and:
  - Degree must have been completed within the prior two years.
  - Student must have earned a GPA of 2.5 or above.
- Maintain a Peirce GPA of 2.5.
- Applicant must provide an unofficial or official community college transcript. The transcript must show a graduation date.
- Individuals must meet all of Peirce College’s admission standards and qualifications before being eligible for this scholarship.

### Awarding of Scholarships

To receive this scholarship award, the applicant must meet all of the scholarship criteria. All documentation must be received prior to the start of session or term. Awards cannot be applied retroactively. This is a “gap” scholarship – other financial resources are applied first and then the scholarship is applied. The scholarship is non-refundable.

Applicants who are receiving a corporate partner tuition discount are not eligible to apply for this award.

This scholarship is renewable for up to 4 years, if the recipient maintains a GPA of 2.5 or above. Continued eligibility is reviewed annually. If a student’s GPA drops below 2.5, he or she will no longer be eligible for the scholarship and cannot reapply. The scholarship will become null and void if the recipient exits Peirce College for a full calendar year.
