Graduation Rates

Peirce College is a non-traditional institution enrolling primarily adult transfer students who attend on a part-time basis. To that end, the College examines completion rates based on a 12-month cohort of all students enrolled in a program.

Per IPEDS, 100% of time to completion for an associate degree = 2 years.

Average graduation rate of the three most recent cohorts to have reached 150% time to degree completion = 15%.

Average graduation rate of the two most recent cohorts to have reached 200% time to degree completion = 23%.
