PHILADELPHIA, May 31, 2016 /PRNewswire/ -- It's a new day for IT education in Philadelphia. This fall, Peirce College will launch the most streamlined bachelor's degree program in Information Technology in the region. By introducing an IT degree in the competency-based education (CBE) format, Peirce will significantly reduce the time to completion and cost for adult learners.

CBE is a fully online, self-paced, personalized way to learn, that uses the knowledge students already have to place them on the most direct path to completing their degree. Rather than basing credits on number of hours spent in a classroom, CBE awards college credit based on a student's mastery of sets of skills, or "competencies," that align with a degree program and, ultimately, the job they want.

"All of the competencies for which we are testing are directly related to skills that would impress an employer," said Dr. Brian Finnegan, assistant dean for Information Technology and General Education. "If it will not help you land a job, it is not a part of our program."

Peirce worked directly with employers to determine the competencies for the program, ensuring they match those desired by today's hiring managers and aligned with the current demands of the marketplace.

The Peirce CBE program is ideal for working adults because it eliminates the need for in-class attendance. Over the course of a term, students can make progress toward their competencies at their own speed, wherever and whenever it works for them. After applying credit for prior college courses and industry certifications that are aligned with the curriculum, students can immediately complete the assessments that are compatible with their previous experience and then focus solely on the areas they still need to learn, eliminating the need to relearn skills they have already mastered.

"Peirce's CBE program focuses on what matters the most to adult learners and their employers? gaining the actual skills and knowledge to do their job better or advance

in their careers," said Vice President for Academic Advancement Rita Toliver-Roberts, Ed.D. "And because you can streamline your education, put what you already know to good use and complete courses at your own pace, competency-based education is the most affordable way to complete your degree."

Students pay a fixed price per term and there is no limit to how many credits they can earn. All students are assigned a dedicated CBE Coach who will ensure they develop a reasonable plan of action. Graduates earn the same accredited degree as if they utilized Peirce'sother delivery platforms.

The College's first CBE program will be a bachelor's degree in Information Technology, with a concentration in Networking, Administration and Information Security. The College will expand the CBE model to additional program areas over the next few years.

## Cheyney's Makkah Hayes Receives National Honor

Makkah Hayes recently graduated summa cum laude from Cheyney University. Because of her academic achievements, she will attend Temple University this fall on a full scholarship. The honors scholar and student leader recently learned that she received the University's first national NSLS award

Makkah Hayes is excited about her future. The 20-year-old just graduated summa cum laude earlier this month from Cheyney University of Pennsylvania with a BA in Psychology and a 3.97 GPA. In addition, the Keystone Honors Academy (KHA)Scholar recently found out that she will receive the Executive Board Member of the Year Award from the National Society of Leadership and Success (NSLS). NSLS, the nation's largest leadership honor society, has more than 500 chapters and nearly 600,000 members nationwide.

'I was excited,' Hayes said, upon learning that she was one of three winners and the first to receive a national award from the Cheyney University NSLS chapter.

'She's an outstanding individual who is a credit to her family, definitely a credit to Cheyney University and definitely a credit to herself,' acknowledges LaMott Moore, Cheyney's NSLS Advisor. 'Makkah is conscientious. When you give her a project or some work, you don't have to worry about it getting done. Her work ethic is outstanding and she is just, flat out, a nice person.'

Not an average student, Hayes has always been driven and appears to excel at whatever she attempts. The North Philadelphia native finished high school at age 16, graduated summa cum laude a year later from Peirce College in Philadelphia with an Associate's degree in Arts and a 4.0 GPA, and decided to get her BA degree from Cheyney.

'I always knew that I was going to attend an HBCU (Historically Black College and University) like my parents and older brothers so, when I visited Cheyney University on my college road trip with my family, I was excited,' she recalls. 'My family has inspired and encouraged me to continue my academic career in higher education. My parents and two older brothers all have graduate degrees in their specific fields of study. Thus, my matriculation at Cheyney University of Pennsylvania was not a goal, but a standard to continue the 'Hayes Family' legacy on excellence, which I am proud to carry on with me in my academic career.'

Hayes says her brothers' and parents' successes motivate her, even now, to be just as good, or better. 'I thank them for all of their modeling, support, love, and encouragement.'

**The KHA Scholarship** that she received paid for her degree and opened up doors.

'The Keystone Honors Academy staff and students encouraged me to be open to opportunities, to network, and connect with the campus community. My parents taught me that an opportunity ignored is an opportunity missed. So, when asked to join, participate, or cooperate with programs, events, services and projects on campus, I obliged.'

'From her very first day in the Keystone Honors Academy, Makkah sought out and pursued every available academic, professional development and service opportunity that membership affords and has demonstrated time and time again, the value of persistence. Peirce College, Philadelphia's leading college for adult learners, has launched its second master's degree program in response to the evolving needs of Philadelphia's healthcare industry.

With the curriculum developed in collaboration with local employers, Peirce's Master of Science in Healthcare Administration (MSHCA) will equip students with relevant healthcare leadership and management skills identified by regional healthcare organizations.

"As the industry adapts to the evolving regulatory framework introduced by the Affordable Care Act, there is an increased need for skilled leaders to guide their teams through this era of change," said Peirce College Dean of Graduate Studies Adrian Zappala. "Our coursework was developed with this specific need in mind."

The curriculum in the MSHCA program was shaped through in-depth discussions and collaboration with some of the region's top healthcare employers.

"The focus groups and conversations we had with our healthcare corporate partners showed that many people in advanced positions generally did not have formal leadership training," Zappala said. "There is such a dire need for healthcare leaders with well-honed soft-skills that companies are recruiting from peer healthcare institutions rather than bringing in new talent. We believe our program will increase the talent pool and fill this need."

All courses will be offered with the flexibility of Peirce Fit, Peirce's new course delivery model that allows students to choose on a week-to-week basis whether to attend class on campus or online.

Students who graduate from the new MSHCA program will be well-prepared to fill positions such as director of compliance, director of research or director of risk management at organizations including insurance firms or large hospitals. The Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry expects employment in healthcare administration in the Philadelphia region to grow by 16 percent from 2012 to 2022.

"This program is the best fit for the mission of Peirce College," Zappala said. "Throughout our more than 150-year history, we have focused on developing the skills of the workforce in a way that benefits individual businesses as well as the overall economy. This program is our latest contribution to that mission."

The Master of Science in Healthcare Administration expands Peirce's graduate level offerings. The College's Master of Science in Organizational Leadership & Management was launched in 2013 and graduated its first class in June 2015. ### Robert W Padgett, 80, loan officer

After Robert W. Padgett married Barbara Carpenter in June 1958, he enlisted in the Army in September and was sent to a base in northeastern France.

Though only a private, he had a friend in a sergeant, who helped get him a three-day pass in November.

So when Mr. Padgett's wife arrived at a Paris airport that month, she met not only her husband but also the sergeant and his wife, who had driven him to this once-in-a-lifetime reunion.

During their time in Paris, the Padgetts dined at the restaurant high on the Eiffel Tower.

"I was expecting something different," something far less, Barbara Padgett said. "I was naive."

On Thursday, May 5, Mr. Padgett, 80, of Williamstown, who retired in 2000 as a loan officer for PNC Bank in Philadelphia, died of a heart attack at home.

While posted in France, Mr. Padgett had been a truck driver at an Army base 25 miles from the town of Bar-le-Duc, in Lorraine.

And because his friend, the sergeant, was in the section that dealt with housing, the Padgetts were able to live in a private home in Bar-le-Duc, where a 1962 census counted slightly more than 18,000 residents.

"I spent nine months with him there," she said, but he was never able to take leave as he did for their Paris encounter.

Born in Haddon Township, Mr. Padgett grew up in Audubon and Haddonfield, graduated from Haddonfield Memorial High School in 1955, and studied business at Peirce College in Philadelphia.

After his military service, he returned to become a teller at Haddonfield National Bank in the early 1960s and then became a loan officer for PNC Bank, first in Fort Washington and then in Center City, before retiring in 2000.

For the last five years, his wife said, he was a member of the finance committee at Centenary United Methodist Church in Berlin.

The pastor, the Rev. June Stitzinger-Clark, said, "He was a gentle, kind, loving man who never raised his voice to anyone."

"He could always be counted on," she said, "to say something positive about everyone's life experiences."

Besides his wife of 57 years, Mr. Padgett is survived by his mother, Ruth; daughter Jodi; and two sisters.

A visitation was set from 10 to 10:45 a.m. Thursday, May 12, at Kain-Murphy Funeral Services, 15 West End Ave., Haddonfield, before an 11 a.m. funeral service there, with interment in Eglington Cemetery in Clarksboro.
