

2023-2024 Graduate/First Destination Survey Report

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report focuses on the employment and educational outcomes of **325** students who graduated from Peirce College in August 2023, December 2023, and May 2024. 350 degrees and certificates were conferred to 325 unique graduates. Data was obtained from **324** graduates, **99.7%** of the individuals who graduated during this time period.

Of the graduates who responded with their employment status, **249 (77%)** are employed, with the majority **(197 of 245 who specified answers, or 80%)** employed in a position related to their field of study. In comparison with the 2022-2023 graduating class, this is a 1% increase in employment and 7% decrease in employment within field of study.

78% of responding graduates indicated that they earned a base salary over **\$40,001** annually, a 2% decrease from the 2022-2023 graduating class and a 4% increase from 2021-2022. **40%** of 2023-2024 graduates reported make over **\$60,001**, the same as the class of 2022-2023. The approximate average salary for the class of 2023-2024 is **\$57,385**.

Top employers for the 2023-2024 graduating class were Penn Medicine (26 employees), JetBlue Airways (22 employees), the City of Philadelphia (10 employees), and Jefferson Health (10 employees).

55% of responding graduates were planning to enroll or already were enrolled in continuing education. This represents a 4% decrease from the previous year.

METHODOLOGY

Data Collection

The graduate surveys were previously reviewed by Faculty Chairs to ensure that relevant information was collected in order to gain needed information for accreditation by the Association of College Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) and approval by the American Bar Association (ABA).

Surveys were deployed electronically to graduates several times throughout the year. As needed, additional information may be collected via phone calls, email, texts, and LinkedIn.

Data Presentation

The percentages for number of students employed and those employed within their field of concentration were tabulated. Comparisons have been made between 2023-24 and the preceding year in order to evaluate outcomes as a group with reference to individual majors. The number of graduates, the number of respondents, their employment status, and employment relation to degree program were compared.

Data reflect self-reported results from graduates that reflect the following areas of study:

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2023-2024 GRADUATE SURVEY OVERALL SYNOPSIS

The 2023-2024 Graduate Employment Survey was deployed to **325** graduates, and information was collected for **324** (**99.7**%) graduates.

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Figure 1. All graduates by program.






Figure 2. Status after Graduation, All Graduates.



Of those respondents who are working and indicated their employment type (employed in the field or elsewhere), the majority of respondents are employed in a field related or somewhat related to their studies except Cybersecurity Certificate graduates.

40% of 2023-2024 graduates reported earning over \$60,001 annually, mirroring the 2022-2023 results. 78% make over \$40,001, a 2% decline from 2022-2023.




Figure 6. Salary of Graduates by Program.

Graduates were surveyed on salary ranges in increments of \$10,000. This chart is an approximate average of annual salary as reported by graduates. Each range was represented as below:

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CONTINUING EDUCATION

Survey recipients were asked about their plans related to continuing education. 44% of graduates who responded to the question planned to enroll in further education, 11% were already enrolled, and 45% had no plans to enroll.

Of the 34 students who reported that they were already enrolled; the majority (32 individuals, or 94% of those who provided information) are continuing to pursue their educational goals at Peirce College, with the remaining enrolled at Rutgers Law School (1) and Liberty University (1).




Figure 7. Continuing Education Plans by Degree Level.

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Certificate Graduates

82 certificates were conferred in the 2023-2024 academic year. Surveys were sent to all certificate graduates with a 100% response rate. Annual base salary data was collected for 55 graduates. **71% are employed, 23% are seeking employment, and 6% are not seeking employment. 68% respondents are employed within a field related to their area of study.**

Certificates were conferred for the following programs: Medical Coding (30), Cybersecurity (11), Client Services (10), Quality Service Management (7), Human Resource Management (6), Project Management Administration (6), Medical Billing (5), Paralegal Studies (3), Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, & Belonging (2), Cloud Computing (1), and IT Support (1).





Figure 8. Reported salaries of certificate program graduates.

Associate Degree Graduates

42 associate degrees were conferred in 2023-2024. Surveys were sent to all with a response rate of 100%. Annual base salary data was collected for 34 graduates. **81% are employed, 12% are seeking employment, 5% are not seeking employment, and 2% are serving in the military. 85% are employed within a field related to their degree.**

Associate degrees were conferred for the following programs: Health Information Technology (13), Business Administration (11), Information Technology (5), General Studies (5), Criminal Justice (3), Paralegal Studies (3), and Leadership Development (1).

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Bachelor Degree Graduates

185 bachelor's degrees were conferred in 2023-2024. Responses were collected from all graduates. 78% are employed, 17% seeking employment, 4% not seeking employment, and 1% serving in the military. 83% are employed within a field related to their degree.

The 195 bachelor's degree program graduates earned degrees in the following programs: Liberal Studies (59), Business Administration (22), Information Technology (21), Organizational Leadership and Management (16), Healthcare Administration (15), Paralegal (12), Accounting (10), Human Services Leadership (10), Criminal Justice (9), Health Information Administration (8), HR (2), and Technology Management (1).

The 59 Liberal Studies Bachelor of Arts graduates earned their degree in the following tracks: Management (17), Leadership (13), Cybersecurity (7), Criminal Justice (5), Quality Service Management (4), Medical Coding (3), IT Support (2), Project Management Administration (2), Human Services Leadership (2), Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, & Belonging (1), Customer Service Management (1), General Business (1), and Human Resource Management (1).

5 of the 22 Business Administration Bachelor of Science graduates earned their degree with a concentration: Management (4) and Leadership (1).

6 of the 21 Information Technology B.S. graduates earned their degree with a concentration: Networking, Admin, & Information Security (3) and Programming and Application Development (3).





Figure 10. Reported salaries of bachelor's degree graduates.

Master of Science Degree Graduates

41 Master of Science (M.S.) degrees were conferred in 2023-2024. Responses were collected from 40 graduates (98%). Of those who responded, **90% are employed, 7.5% are seeking employment, and 2.5% are not seeking employment. 86% are employed within their field of study.**

This year featured the inaugural graduation for the MBA program: 18 graduates received a master's degree in Business Administration. 13 graduates received a master's degree in Organizational Leadership & Management, 9 received a master's degree in Healthcare Administration, and 1 received a degree in Higher Education Leadership (focus in Enrollment Management and Student Services). Of those who received a master's degree in Organizational Leadership & Management, 1 had a focus in Operations Management.

YEAR OVER YEAR COMPARISON

The three-year comparison highlights only the current degree programs and concentrations offered by Peirce. Specifically, the report includes statistics related to the number of graduates, the number responding to survey, the number employed, and the number employed in their field of study.

For the **2023-2024** academic year, 325 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 325, 99.7% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 249 (77%) are employed and 197 (80%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

For the **2022-2023** academic year, 321 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 321, 100% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 243 (76%) are employed and 211 (87%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

For the **2021-2022** academic year, 299 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 299, 99% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 219 (74%) are employed and 158 (73%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

Figure 12. Employment rate comparison, 2017-24.





Figure 13. Job Relation rate comparison, 2017-24.
