EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report focuses on the employment and educational outcomes of **304** students who graduated from Peirce College in August 2020, December 2020, and May 2021. 309 degrees were conferred to 304 unique graduates. Data were obtained from **300** graduates, which represents **98.6%** of the individuals who graduated during this time period.

Of the graduates who responded with their employment status, **209 (70%) are employed**, with the majority **(160 of 207 who specified answers, or 77%) employed in a position related to their field of study**. In comparison with the 2019-2020 graduating class, this is a 5% decrease in employment and 1% decrease in employment within field of study. While the overall rate of employment related to field of study remained fairly consistent from the previous year, it should be noted that graduates in four academic divisions were employed in unrelated fields at a rate greater than or equal to those in related positions: Accounting, Criminal Justice, and Legal Studies in Business. This is a marked change from previous years and may be a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

65% of responding graduates indicated that they earned **over \$40,000 per year**. 45% earned over \$50,000.

Top employers for the 2020-2021 graduating class were the City of Philadelphia (14 employees), Penn Medicine (14 employees), and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (7 employees).

58% of responding graduates were planning to enroll or already were enrolled in continuing education.

METHODOLOGY

Data Collection

The graduate surveys were previously reviewed by Faculty Chairs to ensure that relevant information was collected in order to gain needed information for accreditation by the Association of College Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) and approval by the American Bar Association (ABA).

Surveys were deployed electronically to graduates several times throughout the year. As needed, additional information may be collected via phone calls, email, and LinkedIn.

Data Presentation

The percentages for number of students employed and those employed within their field of concentration were tabulated. Comparisons have been made between 2020-21 and the preceding year in order to evaluate outcomes as a group with reference to individual majors. The number of graduates, the number of respondents, their employment status, and educational transfer patterns were compared.

Data reflect self-reported results from graduates that reflect the following areas of study:

2020-2021 GRADUATE SURVEY OVERALL SYNOPSIS

The 2020-2021 Graduate Employment Survey was deployed to **304** graduates, and information was collected for **300 (98.6%)** graduates. The following is a breakdown of the number of graduates, per concentration, who were sent the survey:

Of the graduates who responded with their employment status, **209 (70%) are employed**, with the majority (**160 of 207 who specified answers, or 77%**) employed in a position related to their field of study.

Figure 1. All graduates by program.

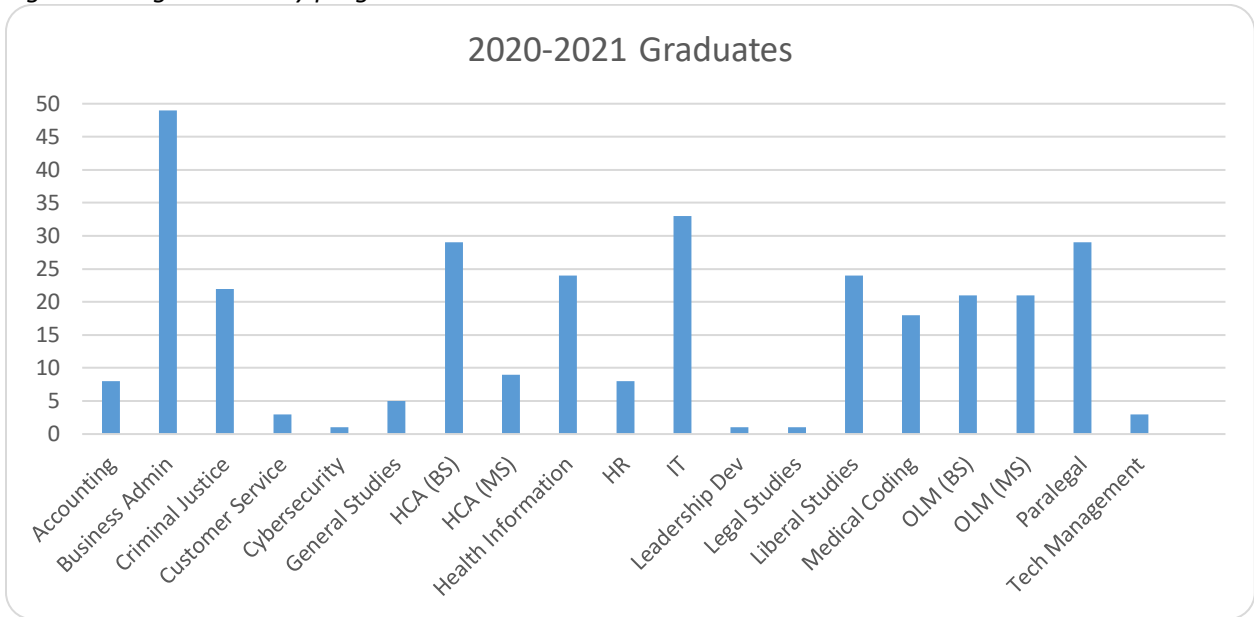


Figure 2. Status after Graduation, All Graduates.

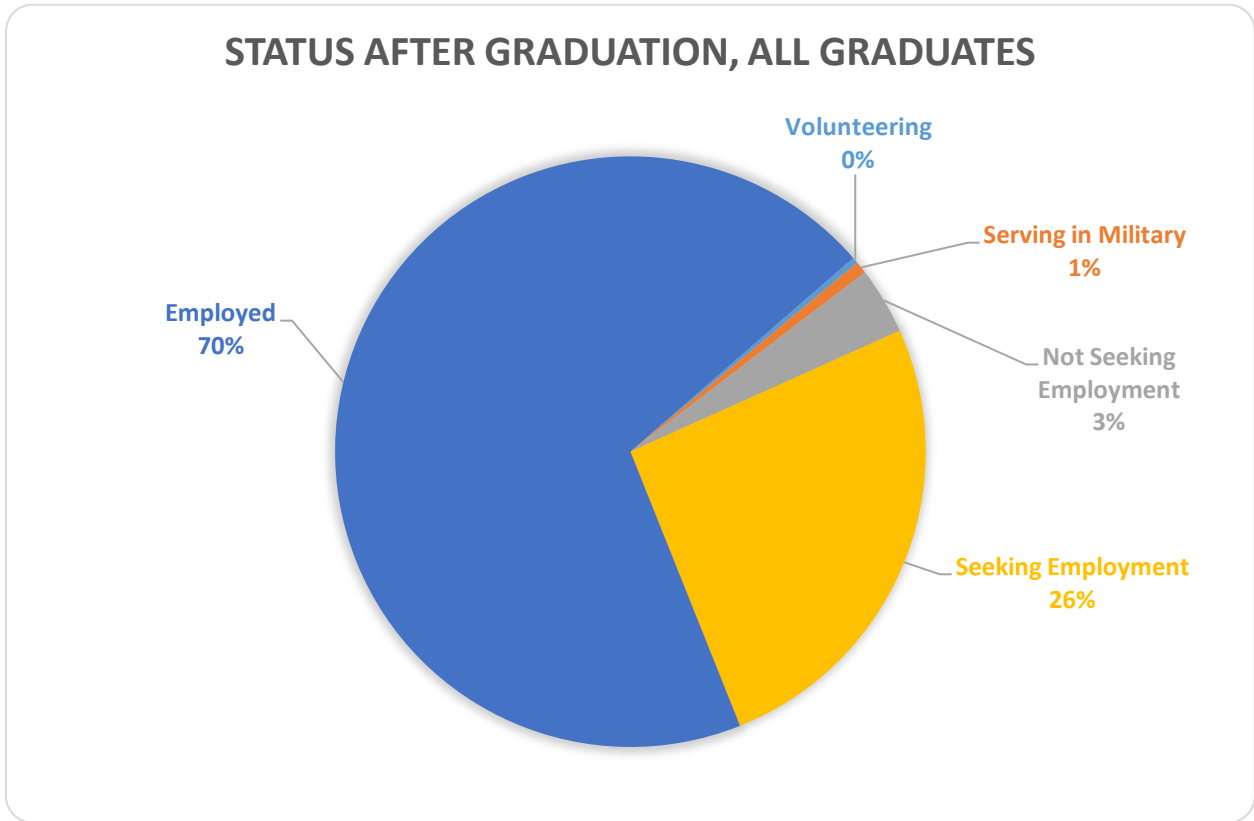


Figure 3. Employment rates by program.

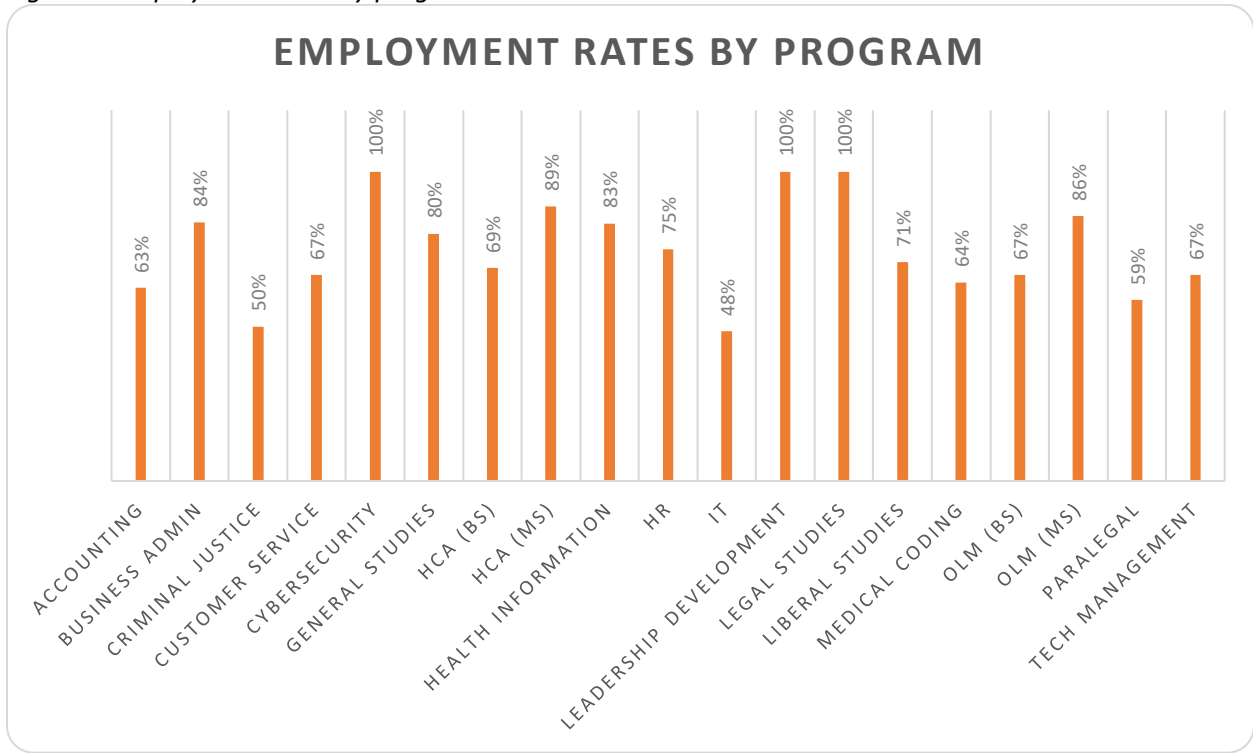
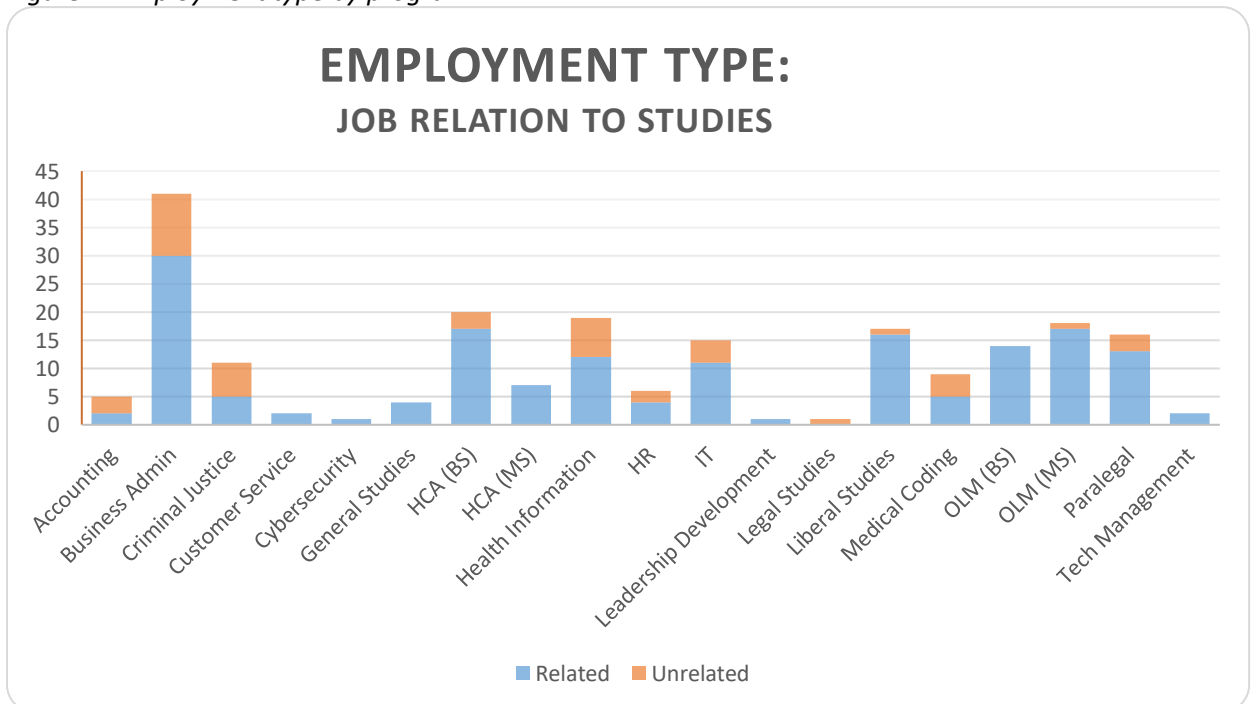


Figure 4. Employment type by program.



Of those respondents who are working and indicated their employment type (employed in the field or elsewhere), the majority of respondents are employed in a field related or somewhat related to their studies. In four academic divisions, graduates were employed in unrelated positions at a rate greater

than or equal to those employed in related positions: Accounting, Criminal Justice, and Legal Studies in Business. This is a departure from previous years and likely a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Figure 5. Salary of All Graduates.

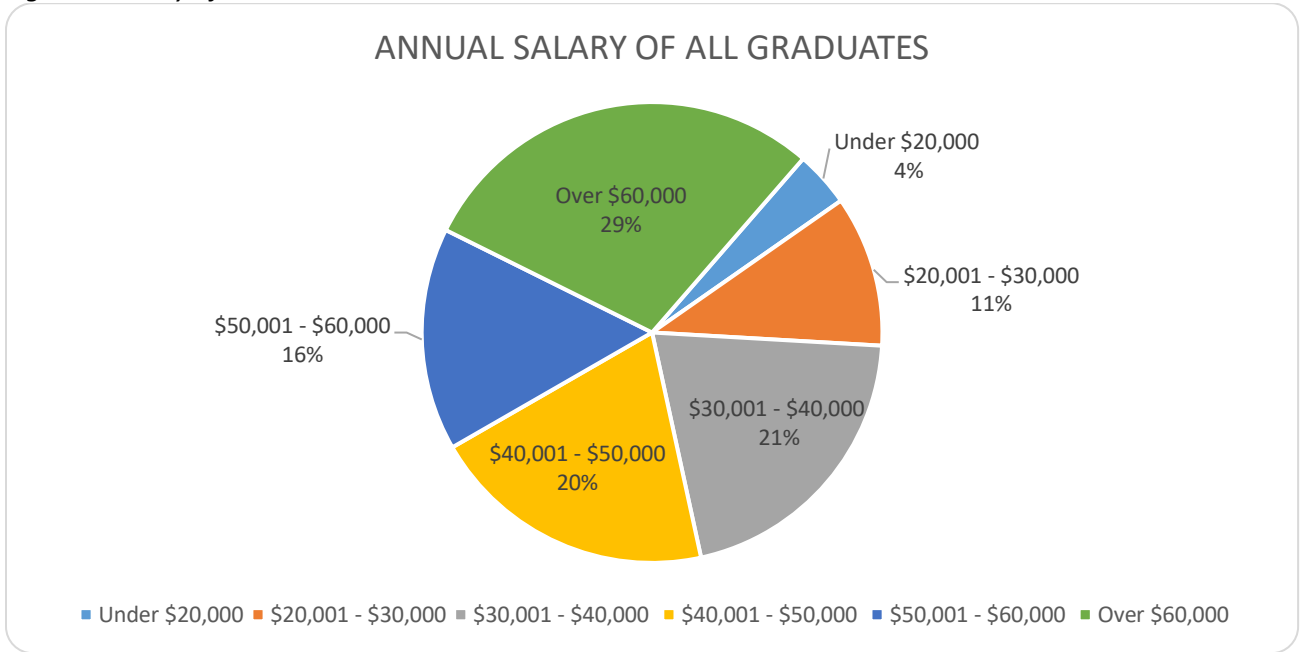
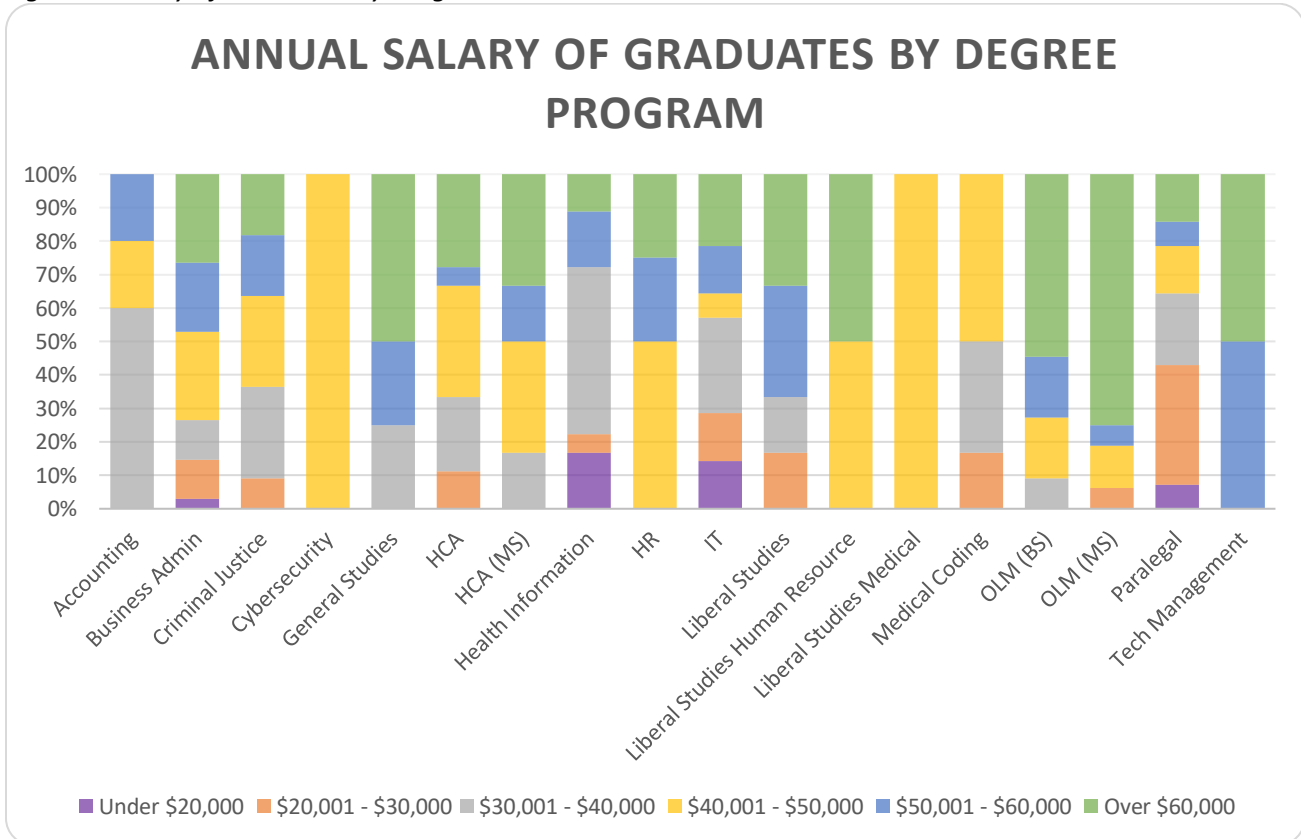


Figure 6. Salary of Graduates by Program.

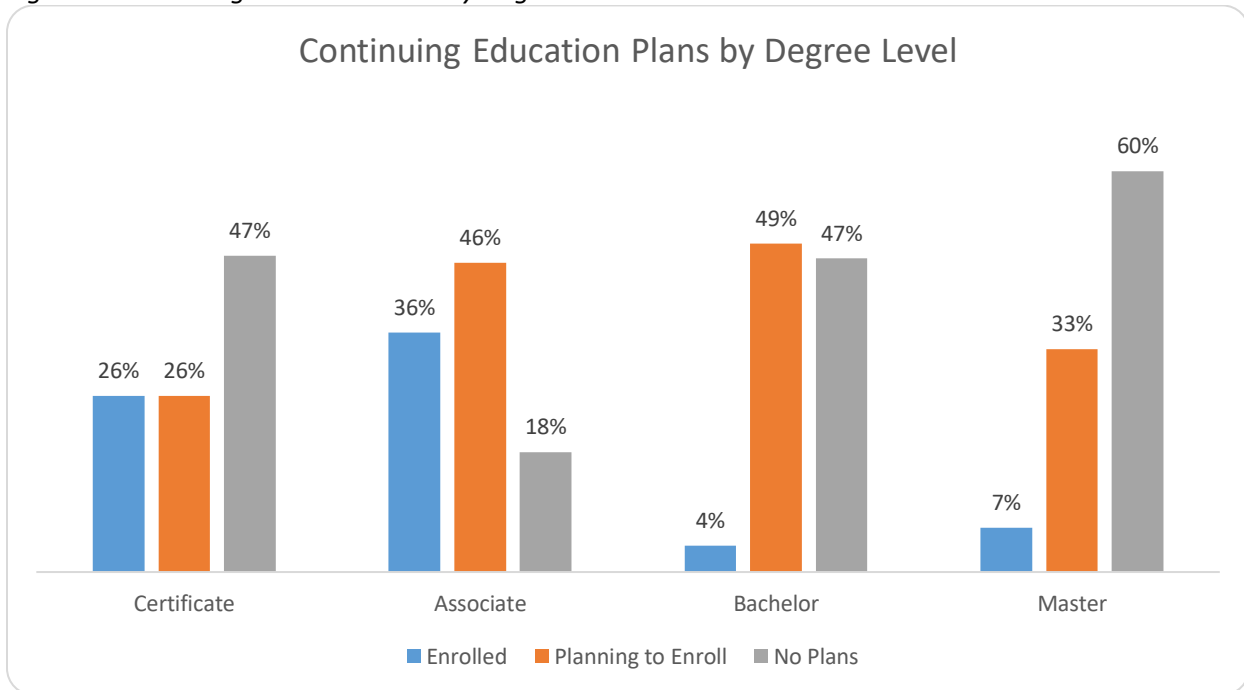


CONTINUING EDUCATION

Survey recipients were asked about their plans related to continuing education. 45% of graduates who responded to the question planned to enroll in further education, 13% were already enrolled, and 42% had no plans to enroll.

Of the 38 students who provided that they were enrolled, 37 provided the institution of enrollment. The majority of these (33 individuals, or 89% of those who provided information) are continuing to pursue their educational goals at Peirce College, with the remaining enrolled at Gwynedd Mercy University (1), University of Virginia (1), Eastern University (1), and Capella University (1).

Figure 7. Continuing Education Plans by Degree Level.



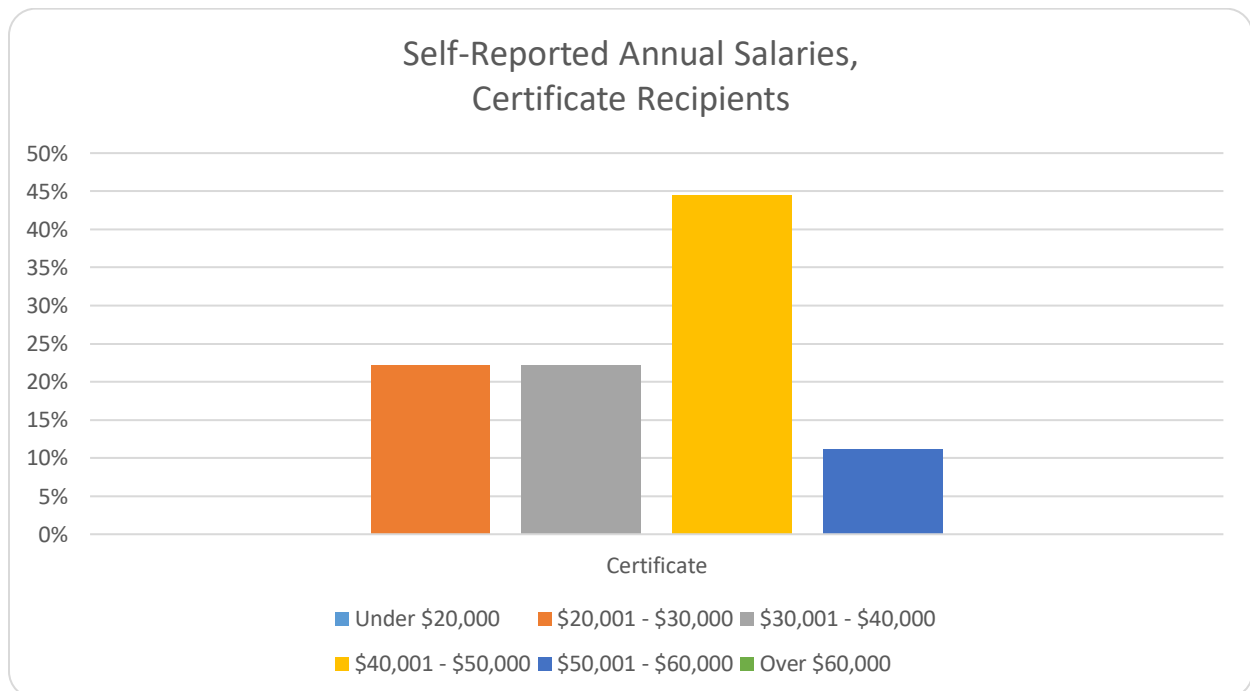
SALARY & EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS BY DEGREE LEVEL

Certificate Graduates

Twenty-eight Peirce College students graduated in the 2020-2021 academic year with a certificate and surveys were sent to all certificate graduates. Twenty-four graduates responded to the survey, with a response rate of 85%, and nine provided information about salary range.

Of the 28 certificate graduates, 18 graduated with a certificate in Medical Coding, 4 in Paralegal Studies, 2 in Customer Service, 1 in Customer Service Management, 2 in Human Resource Management, and 1 in Cybersecurity.

Of the 24 graduates who responded, 16 (67%) are employed, 5 seeking employment, and 3 not seeking employment. 12 out of 16 (75%) respondents are employed within their field of concentration.

Associate Degree Graduates

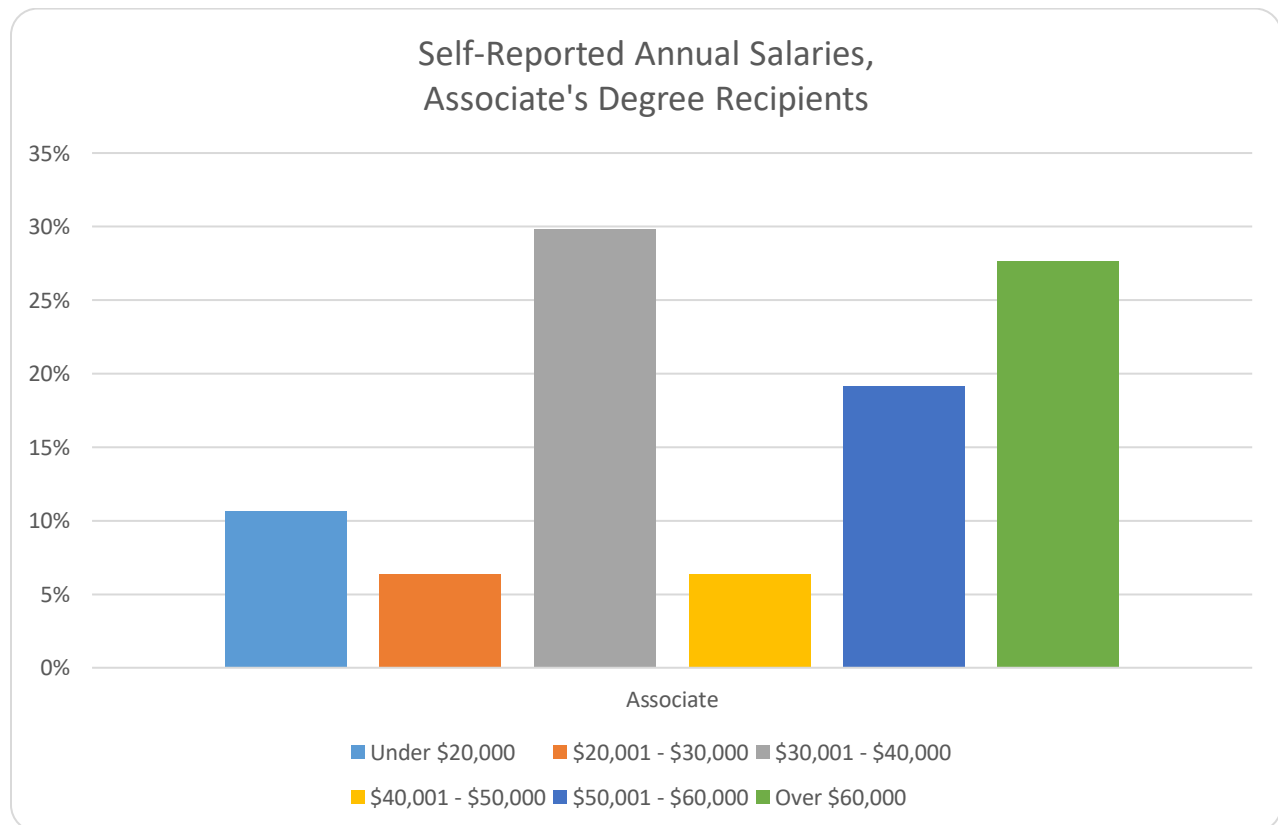
Surveys were sent to all 70 graduates who earned associate degrees in the 2020-2021 academic year. Information was collected for 70 graduates, with a response rate of 100%.

Of the 70 Peirce College students who graduated in the 2020-2021 academic year with an associate degree, 20 graduated with an A.S. in Business Administration, 7 graduated with an A.S. in Criminal Justice Studies, 5 graduated with an A.A. in General Studies, 22 graduated with an A.S. in Health Information Technology, 7 graduated with an A.S. in Information Technology, 1 graduated with an A.S. in Leadership Development, and 8 graduated with an A.S. in Paralegal Studies.

Of the 18 Business Administration A.S. graduates, 2 graduated with a concentration in Management.

Of the 70 graduates who responded with their employment status, 51 (73%) are employed, 17 are seeking employment, 1 not seeking employment, and 1 in a volunteer program. 36 (71%) are employed within their field of concentration.

Bachelor Degree Graduates

In the 2020-2021 academic year, **181** Peirce College students graduated with a bachelor’s degree. Of the 181 bachelor’s degree program graduates, 8 graduated with a degree in Accounting, 29 graduated with a degree in Business Administration, 15 graduated with a degree in Criminal Justice, 29 graduated with a degree in Healthcare Administration, 2 graduated with a degree in Health Information Administration, 6 graduated with a degree in Human Resource Management, 26 graduated with a degree in Information Technology, 1 graduated with a degree in Legal Studies in Business, 24 graduated with a degree in Liberal Studies, 21 graduated with a degree in Organizational Leadership & Management, 17 graduated with a degree in Paralegal Studies, and 3 graduated with a degree in Technology Management.

Of the 29 Business Administration B.S. graduates, 15 graduated with a concentration in Management, 1 graduated with a concentration in Marketing, and 2 graduated with a concentration in Entrepreneurship/Small Business Management.

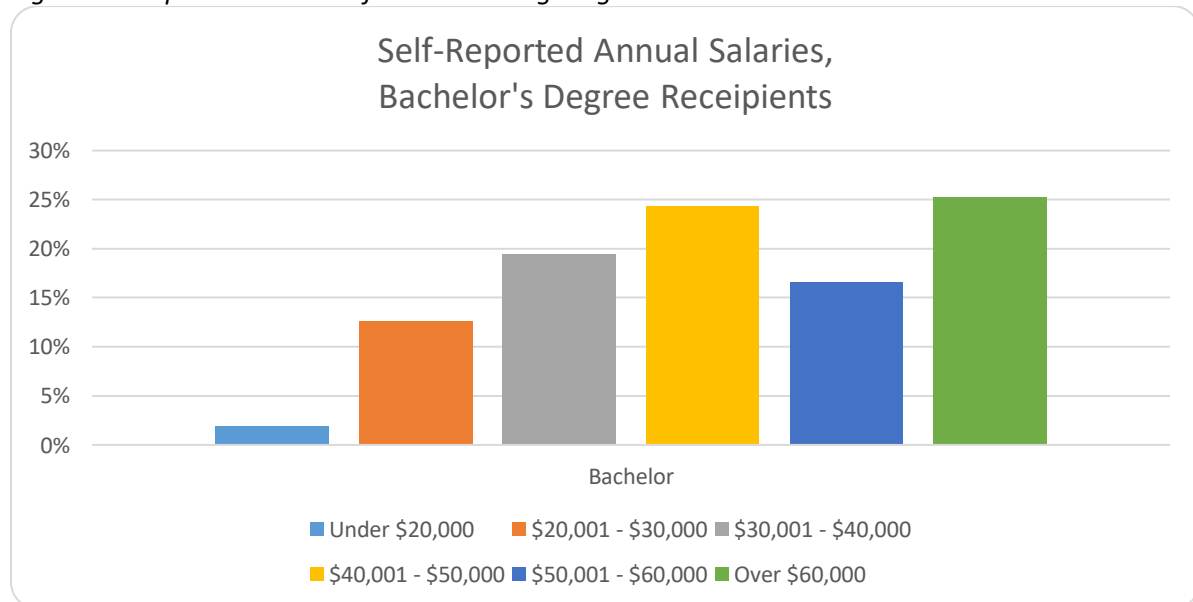
Of the 26 Information Technology B.S. graduates, 18 graduated with a concentration in Networking, Admin, & Information Security and 5 graduated with a concentration in Programming and Application Development.

Of the 24 Liberal Studies B.A. graduates, 4 graduated in the Cybersecurity track, 3 graduated in the Human Resource Management track, 4 graduated in the Leadership track, 10 in the Management track, and 3 in the Medical Coding track.

Surveys were sent to 181 bachelor graduates. Information was collected for 181 graduates, with a response rate of 100%.

Of the graduates who responded, 120 (66%) are employed, 52 seeking employment, 7 not seeking employment, and 2 serving in the military. Of those who provided job relation, 91 (77%) are employed within their field of concentration.

Figure 10. Reported salaries of bachelor’s degree graduates.



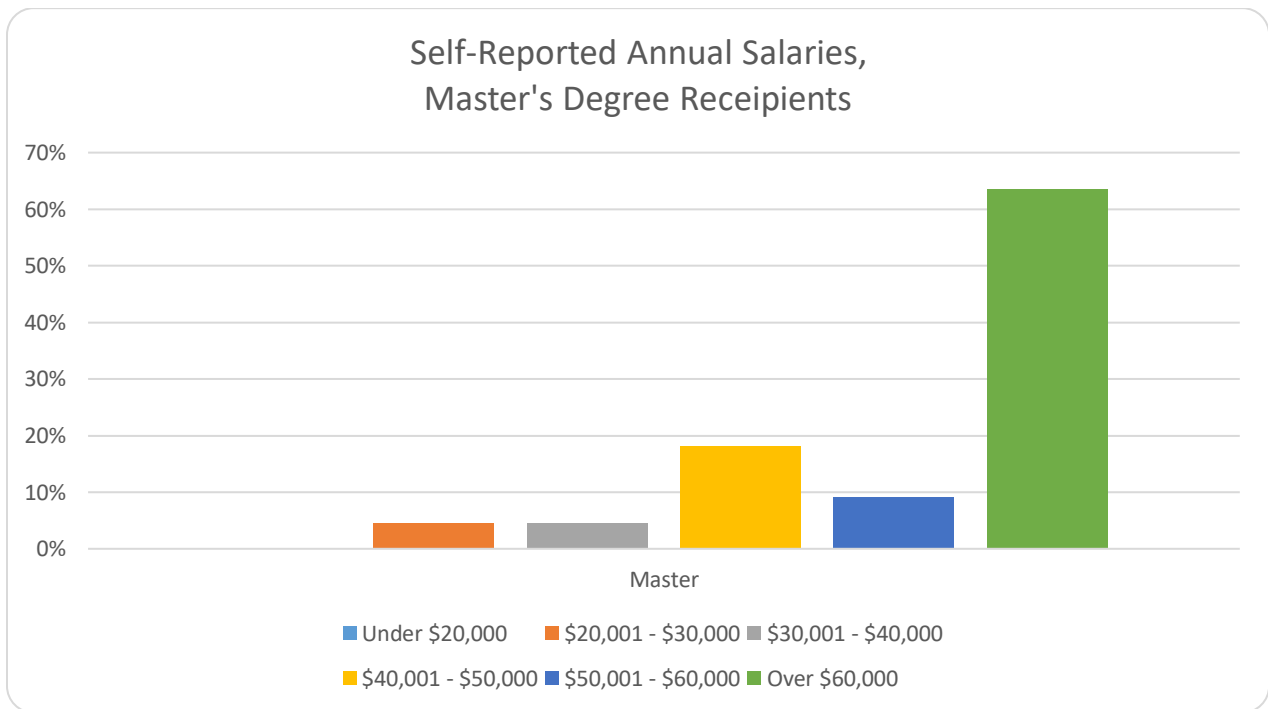
Master of Science Degree Graduates

In the 2020-2021 academic year, **30** Peirce College students graduated with a Master of Science (M.S.) degree. 9 received a master’s degree in Healthcare Administration and 21 graduates received a degree in Organizational Leadership and Management.

Surveys were sent to 30 M.S. graduates, all of whom responded to the survey; the response rate is 100%.

Of the graduates who responded, 26 are employed (86%), 3 are seeking employment, and 1 not seeking employment. (96%) are employed within their field of concentration.

THREE-YEAR COMPARISON: 2018-2019, 2019-2020, AND 2020-2021 EMPLOYMENT RATES

The three-year comparison highlights only the current degree programs and concentrations offered by Peirce. This review includes associate and bachelor's degrees in Accounting, Business Administration, Criminal Justice Studies, General Studies, Healthcare Administration, Health Information Administration, Health Information Technology, Human Resource Management, Information Technology, Leadership Development, Legal Studies in Business, Liberal Studies, Organizational/Integrated Leadership, Paralegal Studies, and Technology Management as well as certificate programs in Customer Service, Customer Service Management, Human Resource Management, Cybersecurity, Medical Coding, and Paralegal Studies and master's degrees in Healthcare Administration and Organizational Leadership and Management. Specifically, the report includes statistics related to the number of graduates, the number responding to survey, the number employed, and the number employed in their field of study.

For the **2020-2021** academic year, 304 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 304, 98.6% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 209 (70%) are employed and 160 (77%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

For the **2019-2020** academic year, 302 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 302, 98.7% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 220 (74%) are employed and 169 (78%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

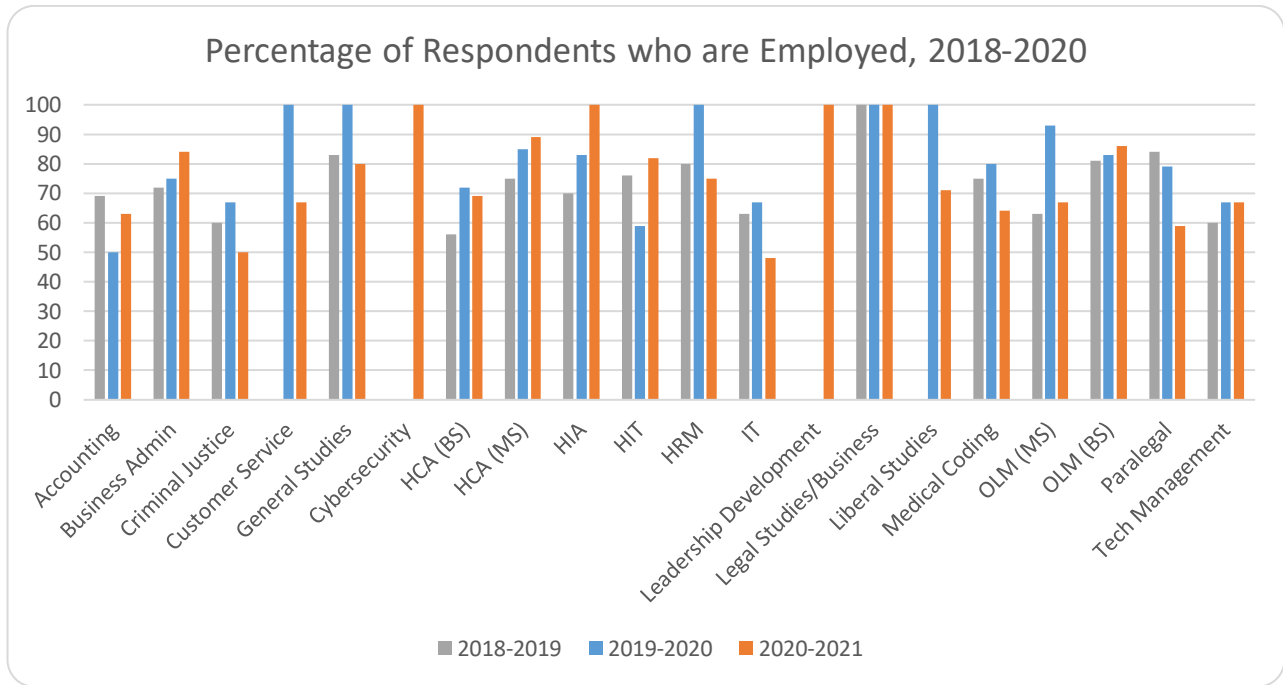

Excluding non-respondents, 224 (72%) are employed and 166 (77%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.
